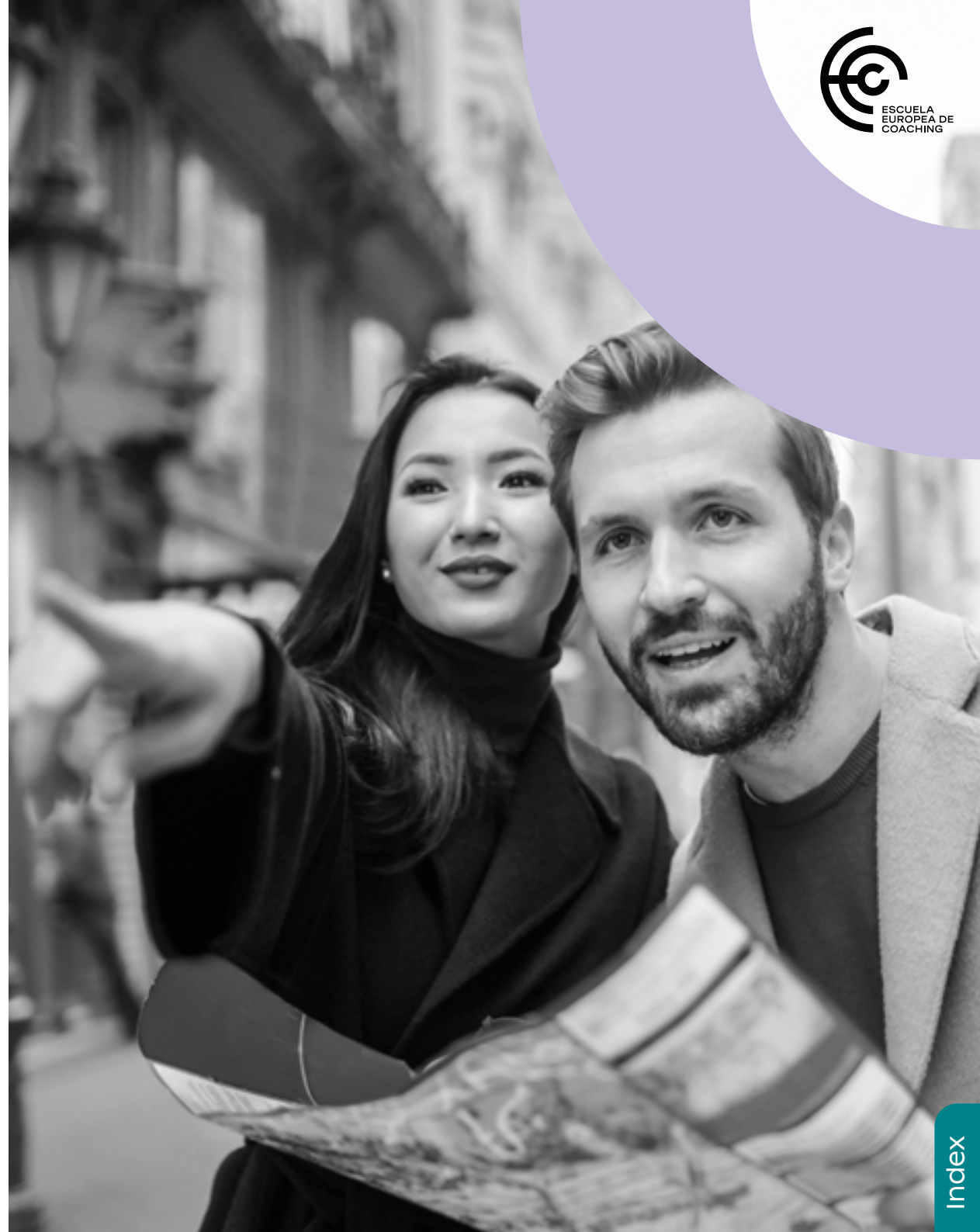


Program overview
